The District will recognize the outstanding achievement of its graduating seniors in the following manner:

Valedictorian/Salutatorian/Scholar Graduate Recognition: Clinton High School will recognize our Valedictorian(s) as the graduate(s) with the highest grade point average in the senior class based on their 7th semester cumulative G.P.A. The Salutatorian(s) will be defined as the graduate(s) with the second-highest grade point average based on their 7th semester cumulative G.P.A. Academically qualified students who have earned a 4.0+ grade point average based on their 7th semester cumulative G.P.A. will be recognized as a Clinton High School Scholar. Subject to change per Board Policy.

Grading Scale for Determining Cumulative GPA:

- A. All on-level courses will be computed on a 4 point scale;
- B. All AP class grades will be computed on a 5 point scale;
- C. All Dual Enrollment classes will be computed on a 4 point scale;
- D. All other online class grades will be computed on a 4 point scale and all Credit Recovery Classes will be graded on a 4.0 basis.
